This *Piano Quartet* has been written with the express intention of writing tonal music, focusing on melody writing. Having spent an extended period of time exploring atonal composition I felt that I wanted to indulge myself in trying to hone my tune-smithing skills. The *Quartet* is set in three movements, with the melodic material for the outer two movements being modal, hopefully giving a hint at my interest in folk music. The central movement is cantabile in style, and firmly based in F major.

I am hopeful that players and listeners will enjoy the piece for its coherent melodic and structural qualities. Players should not try to take the music too seriously, but should feel free to make interpretative decisions at will, within the stylistic nature of the piece.




